November

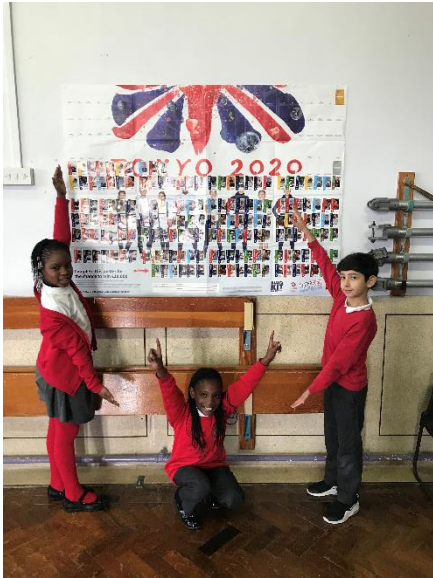
